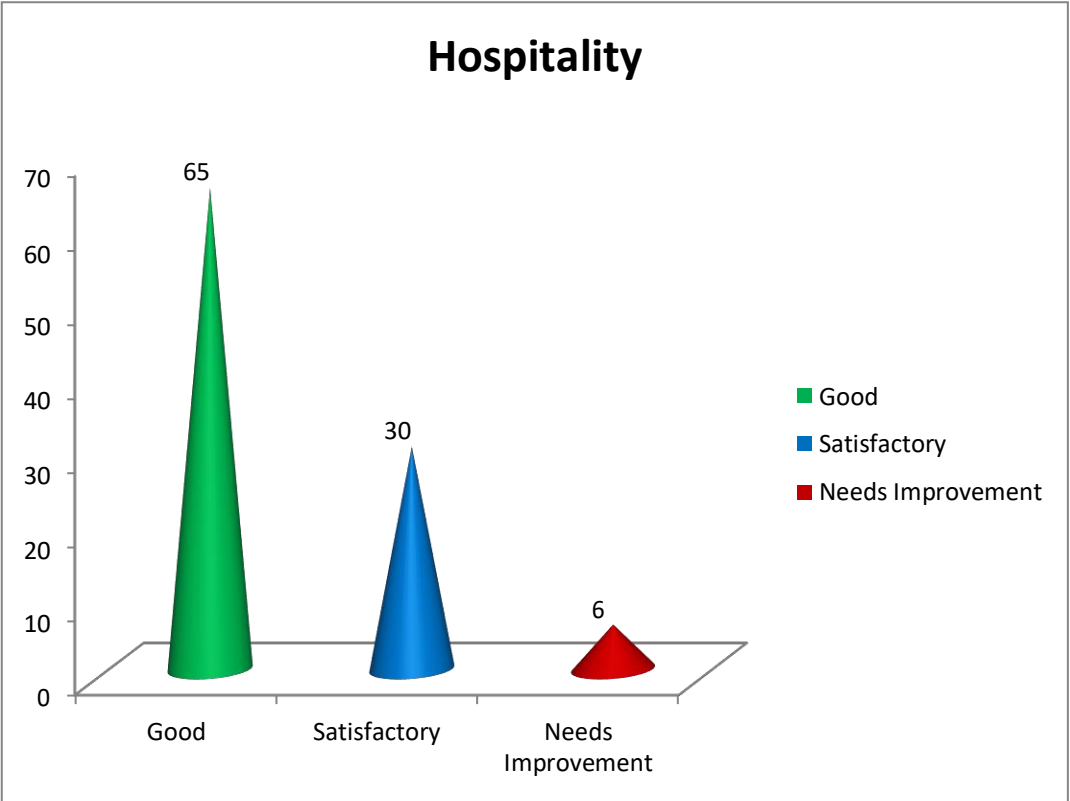
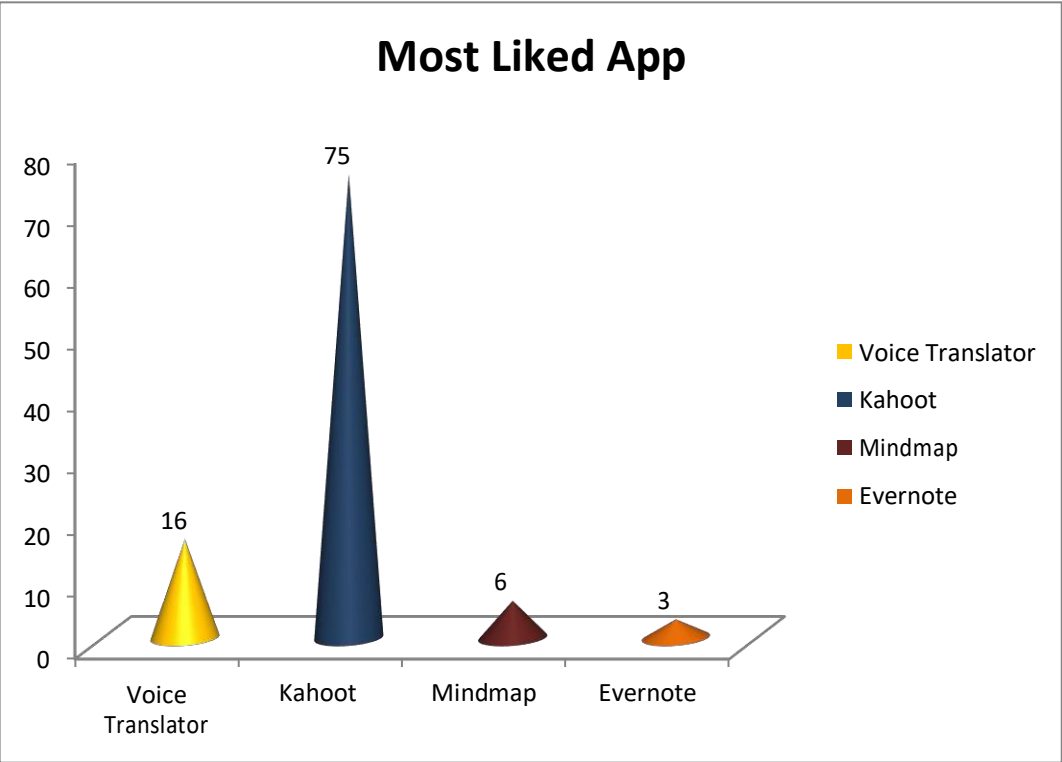
This workshop on “Techno-Centric Classrooms” recommends the participants

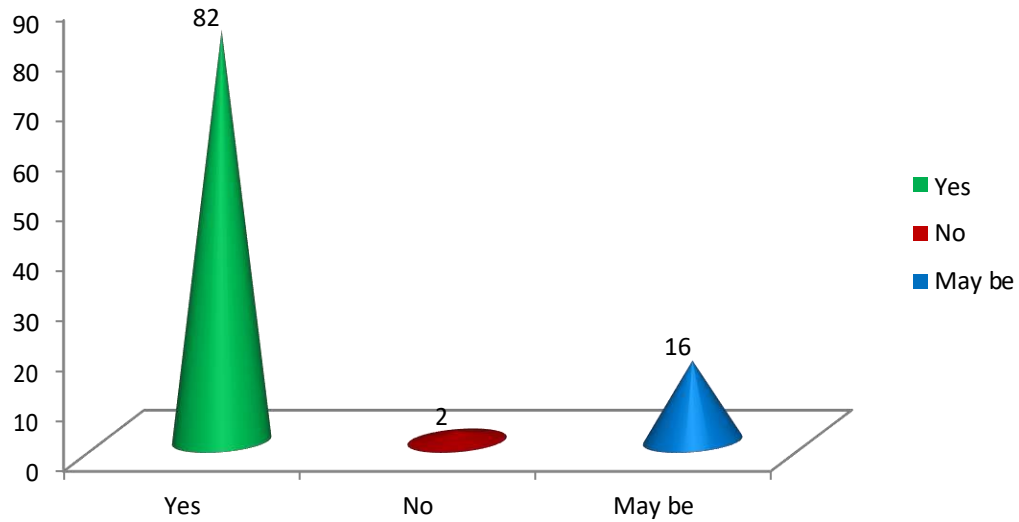

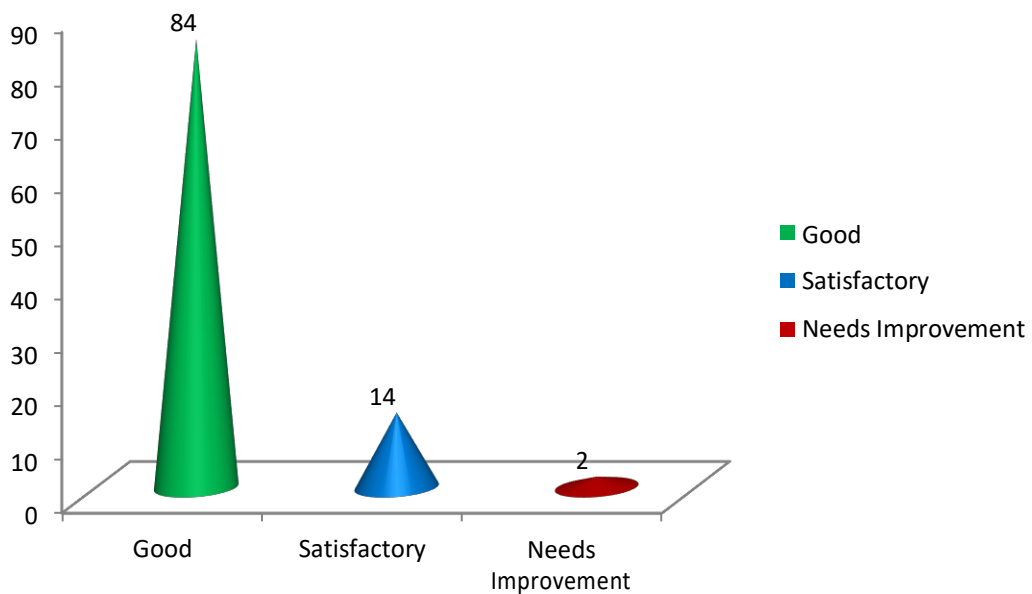




Preference to attend the workshop in the future
